Course Description and Outline:

He is the President and founder of Connecticut Kids Play Chess, Inc. a non-profit organization that provides chess lessons to Connecticut schools based on a proven curriculum.

(1) **Beginners' Chess** - for those who have never played chess or have just started playing, specifically in Grades 2~5, or those returning from last year's Beginners' class; ten weekly 60-minute classes; Wednesdays after school.

(2) **Advanced Chess** – for all other students, specifically in Grades 5~8, including students presently enrolled in Friday Chess; ten weekly 90-minute classes; Fridays after school.
